Description: Dr. Demetree will present the findings of her mixed methods study to explore residents' perceptions of two formats for implementing morbidity and mortality conferences, aiming to identify the relative challenges and advantages of these for promoting resident learning and professional development.

Description: Dr. Zapien collaborated in the development of the Bilingual Medical Spanish Distinction Track at the University of Arizona College of Medicine-Tucson and has been involved in Medical Spanish activities with pre-med students for several years. She will present the findings of her mixed methods study documenting the progress of the program in its first year, including exploring medical students' perceptions, and possible indicators for success in the track including student language background and performance on language and standardized clinical examinations.
