Dr. Hafler runs an active research program applying qualitative research methods in medical education. She collaborates with and mentors clinicians and faculty on the elements of qualitative research in the field of medical education and medical care.

Dr. Hafler has published many book chapters, curriculum materials and original articles in medical education and clinical journals.
