


For PCs with Windows 8

Go to the START screen & SEARCH for “speech recognition”



For Windows 7 or earlier operating systems

- Go to lower left screen and click on Start
 - In the search box, type Speech recognition
- OR -

- Go to CONTROL PANEL, EASE OF ACCESS, and SPEECH RECOGNITION

You will need the following:

- Microphone (you might be able to use your iPhone or smart phone microphone integrated with your earbuds)

No matter what Microsoft operating system you're using, you will see the control panel below for setting up your microphone and training the software to recognize your voice.
